We mentioned last month that we were preparing for this month's medical brigade. We are so thankful for the Southside Church of Christ leaders and members who have made this annual trip possible. We are also grateful for the other members of this brigade that are not from Kentucky! We are blessed to have a group that is made up of individuals from several different States, but who come together and work in harmony each year to serve our community. They are incredible to see in action!

While participating in this brigade, we were told by the community leaders that we are the very first group that has ever come to their area to serve them in this way. This was a great first impression to give that community of who we are, our love for them, and to share the love of Christ.

This year, as we served in this smaller community, we didn't have the same number of people attending every day, though we did see 647 patients in three days! With being able to spend a little more time with each person than in past years, we offered to pray with anyone that wanted prayers. It was such a beautiful sight to see small groups huddled up praying as well as one on one prayers. Two of the three people we had praying with these individuals are some of our newest Christians. They wanted to serve and stepped up in such a big way. We are thankful to see God working through them.

Our desire for next year is to send our RADICAL team into these communities to teach God's Word and values in their schools. We are asking God to make this plan a reality.
